**2021 ADOPTED BUDGET RESOLUTION'**

**JACKSON TOWNSHIP F.D. NO.3**

**FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2021 TO DECEMBER 31, 202**

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget for Jackson Township Fire District No.3 for the year beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021 has been presented for adoption before the Board of Fire Commissioners F.D.. NO.3 Jackson Twp. at its open public meeting of January 21, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, The annual budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the adopted budget is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.); and

**WHEREAS**, the annual budget as presented for adoption reflects total revenues of \$3,554,794.00 which includes the amount to be raised by taxation of \$3,287,637.00 and total appropriations of \$3,554,794.00; and

**WHEREAS**, an election shall be held on April 20, 2021 pursuant to Executive Order issued by the Governor's office of the State of New Jersey o determine the amount of money to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No.3 Jackson Township at an open public meeting held on January 21, 2021 that the annual budget proposed for the fiscal year beginning on January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021 is hereby adopted and shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated and authorization of Total Revenues of \$3,554,794.00 which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$3,287,637.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the annual budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue in the same amount and title as set forth in

the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the annual election shall be held on April 20, 2021 to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year, the results of which shall be subsequently certified to the Division and the Municipal Assessor.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS FIRE  
DISTRICT NO.3 JACKSON TOWNSHIP SCHEDULING A BOND  
REFERENDUM FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE APPARATUS**

**WHEREAS;** The Board of Fire Commissioners has determined that it is necessary, proper and in the public interest to purchase one new Class A Fire Engine Pumper to replace an older outdated apparatus that has reached the end of its expected service life; and

**WHEREAS;** The periodic replacement of fire apparatus is required due to the harsh conditions and emergency circumstances under which fire apparatus operate; and

**WHEREAS;** The best way to insure the safety and efficiency of firefighters performing essential public service is to provide them with the best and latest firefighting equipment and apparatus when replacement of existing apparatus is required due to usage and wear of existing apparatus and equipment; and

**WHEREAS;** N.J.S.A. 40A: 14-85 authorizes fire commissioners to purchase fire apparatus by issuing bonds or notes or entering into a lease/purchase agreement with a vendor; and

**WHEREAS;** Before a resolution authorizing the purchase of firefighting apparatus can become effective, it must be submitted to and approved by the District's voters at public referendum; and

**WHEREAS;** The estimated cost of one new Class A Pumper fire engine is approximately **SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000.00)**.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No.3 Jackson Township that a bond referendum shall be held on **April 20, 2021** in conjunction with the annual budget referendum and election of Commissioner with the polls to be open between the hours of 2:00 and 9:00 p.m. and the polling station at the Fire District Headquarters Firehouse 200 Kiercyh Memorial Drive Jackson Township, N.J.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that at the referendum the following question shall be presented to the voters:

**BALLOT QUESTION**
