

Motion to adjourn the meeting at approximately 8:30 pm by Commissioner Brito 2nd by Commissioner Keller. Vote: All Aye.



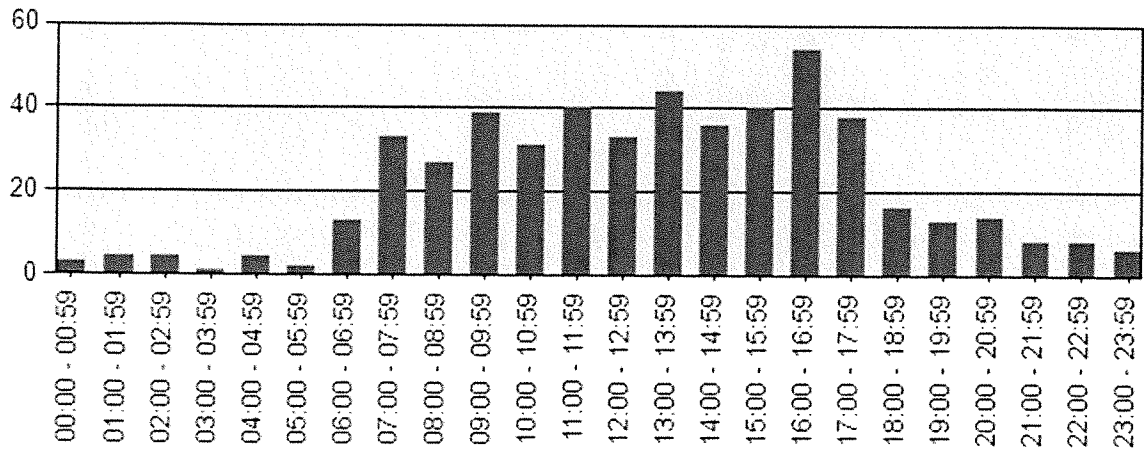

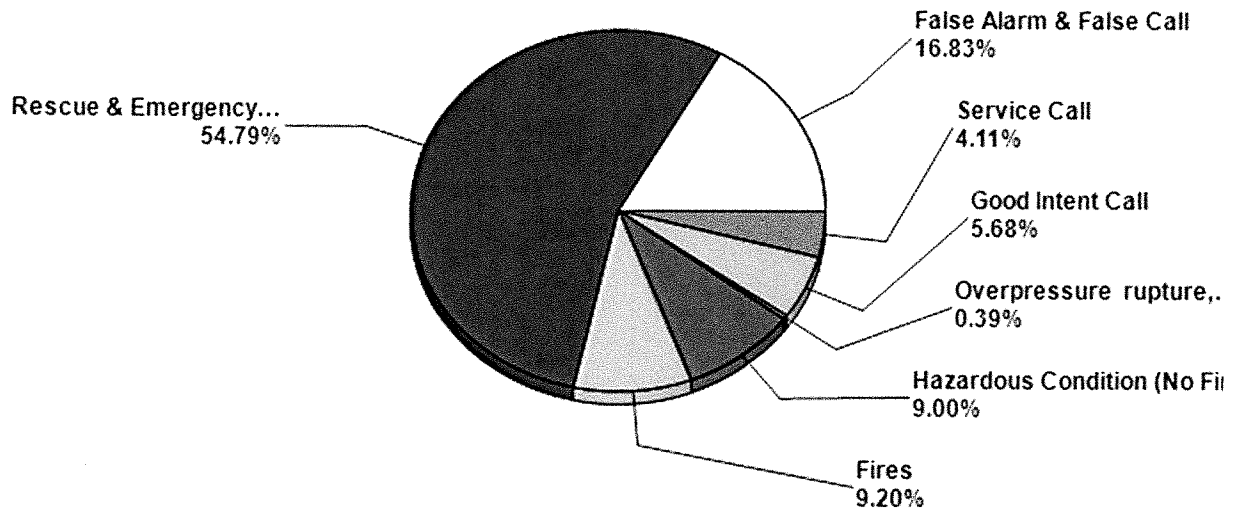

The Fire Bureau has done one fire investigations since last month commissioners meeting.
